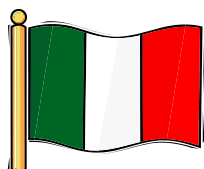
PIC'N' MIX EVENT MANICURES

if any other children would like to join as it is now a very small group.

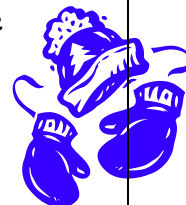
NETBALL TRIUMPH
